

Thank you for ordering Camping Wristbands for VSCC Prescott. Whether you are a competitor, official, marshal or spectator, we wish you an enjoyable, peaceful and dry weekend.



Important Information

The campsite will open at 1pm on Friday 2 August. Please do not plan to arrive ahead of this time as doing so may cause traffic problems and <u>disruption to the farm operations at a critical time</u>. **There is no holding area available at the site**.

The campsite entrance is best approached from the west (Cheltenham and Bishops Cleeve). If you are using SatNav, the postcode is GL52 9RD. To assist security staff, please have your wristbands on prior to arrival.

If you have camped previously at Prescott and hope to occupy your 'traditional' location, please be aware that some areas of A field have been fenced off and will not be available this year. This has been necessary to aid access control and security and also to reduce disturbance to local residents. The areas so restricted have been marked on the map.

Also note that, for safety and liability reasons, the farm sheds and hardstanding are <u>strictly</u> out of bounds apart from transit. Children were found playing there in previous years while it was an active area for heavy farm vehicles. If this happens again, it risks damaging our relationship with the local farmer. Please ensure your children are supervised and not accessing this area at any time.

Wristbands must be worn at all times

An individual wristband is required for each person over the age of 16 who is camping.

Cars, ancient and modern, may be parked next to your pitch, but vehicular movement should be kept to a minimum and at low speed.

Please do not stop, park, unload or load trailers on the hardstanding over which you will pass to enter the camping field.

Campsite Rules

- No open fires or braziers.
- BBQs are permitted but must be supervised and kept away from vehicles or tents. Please ensure that BBQs are safely extinguished once they have been used.
- No fireworks of any kind.
- Children and minors must be supervised at all times and must not be left unsupervised on the campsite.
- The use of 'Silent Discos' is not permitted.
- Vehicle movement is to be minimised and vehicles should be driven slowly and with great care. Pedestrians have right of way at all times.
- Except in case of emergency, there is to be NO vehicle movement, or access or egress from the site between midnight and 7am on Friday and Saturday.
- Fire lanes MUST be kept clear at all times.
- Curfews. The campsite is to be quiet from 1130pm and silent from midnight until 6am. THIS IS A SAFETY ISSUE COMPETITORS, OFFICIALS AND MARSHALS NEED THEIR SLEEP.
- Fuel for competition must not be stored in the campsite.
- Please come prepared to minimise the amount of rubbish you generate and bring bags in which to place it before putting it in the skips. In particular ALL FOOD WASTE is to be secured in bags before putting it in the skip. Do NOT place BBQ debris in the skips unless you are sure it is COMPLETELY cold.
- Please take all automotive debris away with you and do not leave tyres, broken vehicle components, waste oil etc. Doing so will cause considerable difficulty and cost for the Club.
- Please be aware that purchase of wristbands implies that you will accept responsibility for the behaviour of all the people your purchased them for. In the event of any problems be aware that there are professional security personnel on site whose assistance you can seek.

Please remember that everyone is entitled to enjoy Prescott in their way – so be considerate and responsible and don't do anything that will spoil the event for others or threaten our ability to run this iconic event in the future.
